Tyerri Yoo-rrook: Truth-telling report and online event

First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria

Wa Wa Gee (Taungurung) friends,

Treaty and truth-telling go hand in hand. To build a better and fairer future, we need to reckon with the past so we can heal the lingering wounds of invasion and racism and come together with a shared understanding.

Since the First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria was formed, a clear message we've received from Community everywhere is that Truth-telling is an incredibly important first step for the journey towards Treaty.

That's why we set to work and successfully negotiated the establishment of the Yoo-rrook Justice Commission – an authority that will have statutory powers to investigate the injustices experienced by First Peoples since colonisation.

Today we're pleased to share with you our Tyerri Yoo-rrook (Seeds of Truth) report which outlines the various requirements, requests and hopes that mob have explained they have for the truth-telling process.
